

Low Emissions Vehicle Toll Incentive Scheme

The LEVTI Scheme is an expansion on the previous Electric Vehicle Toll Incentive Scheme that commenced in June 2018; it will run until June 30th 2023.



Small Public Service Vehicles includes Taxis; Hackneys and Limousines.



LEV Passenger Cars and Light Goods Vehicles includes Battery Electric Vehicle (BEV); Fuel Cell Electric Vehicles (FCEV); or Plug-in Hybrid Electric Vehicle (PHEV) with CO²



Heavy Duty Vehicles includes trucks; buses and coaches.



- Conventional Hybrid vehicles are not covered by the scheme.
- The vehicle must be a registered vehicle in the EU or the UK.
- Goods vehicles will be eligible if they meet the criteria and have a vehicle design gross weight exceeding 3,500 kilogrammes.
- Small Public Service vehicles (Taxis, Hackneys and Limousines) meeting the scheme vehicle criteria will be considered as a LEV Passenger Cars and Light Goods Vehicles under this scheme with the different refunds applicable.
- Participating vehicles must have a toll tag and be registered and approved for the LEVTI scheme by an LEVTI toll tag provider.
